### INTERN PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT DAY

The interns had their first professional development day on Monday, October 24 lead by Krista Happ, Steph Rosborg and Marin Lindberg. It was an all-day event where they learned about some of the elements of Responsive Classroom, specifically Morning Meeting, and were able to plan a Morning Meeting lesson to put into practice back in their classroom.

They learned about how creating community influences classroom management and how to apply elements of Responsive Classroom to not just elementary school, but middle school and high school as well. They learned about Teacher Language and how to use language to foster positive relationships, and classroom manage.

Late in the day we also had a little time to practice some English and answer some questions that they had. It was a really beneficial time of learning and community, and we are already looking forward to our next time of learning together!

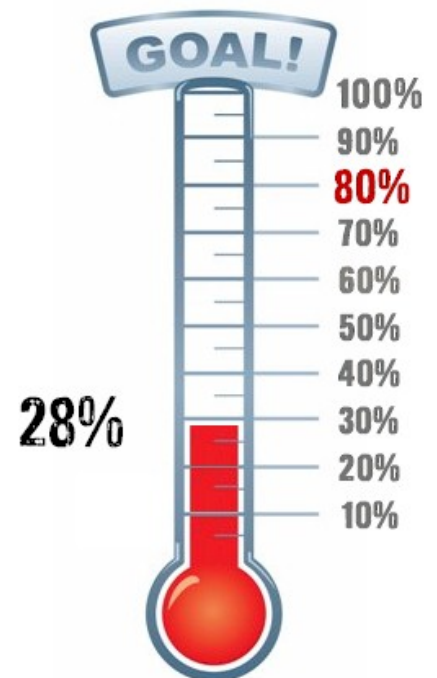
### FALL INTERN FESTIVAL
